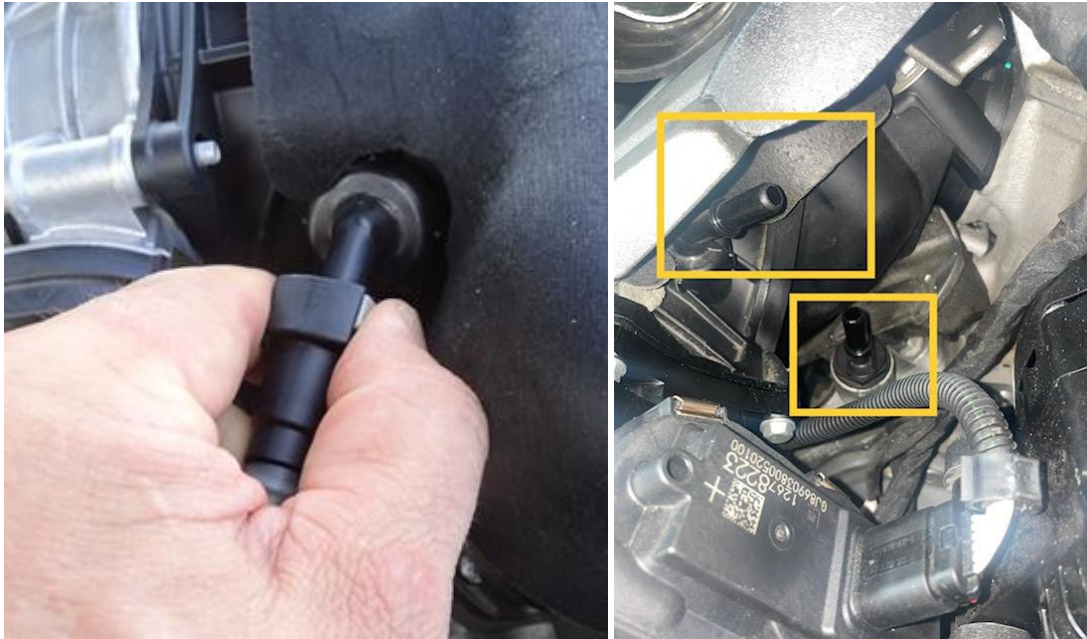


## UPR Oil Catch Can Installation

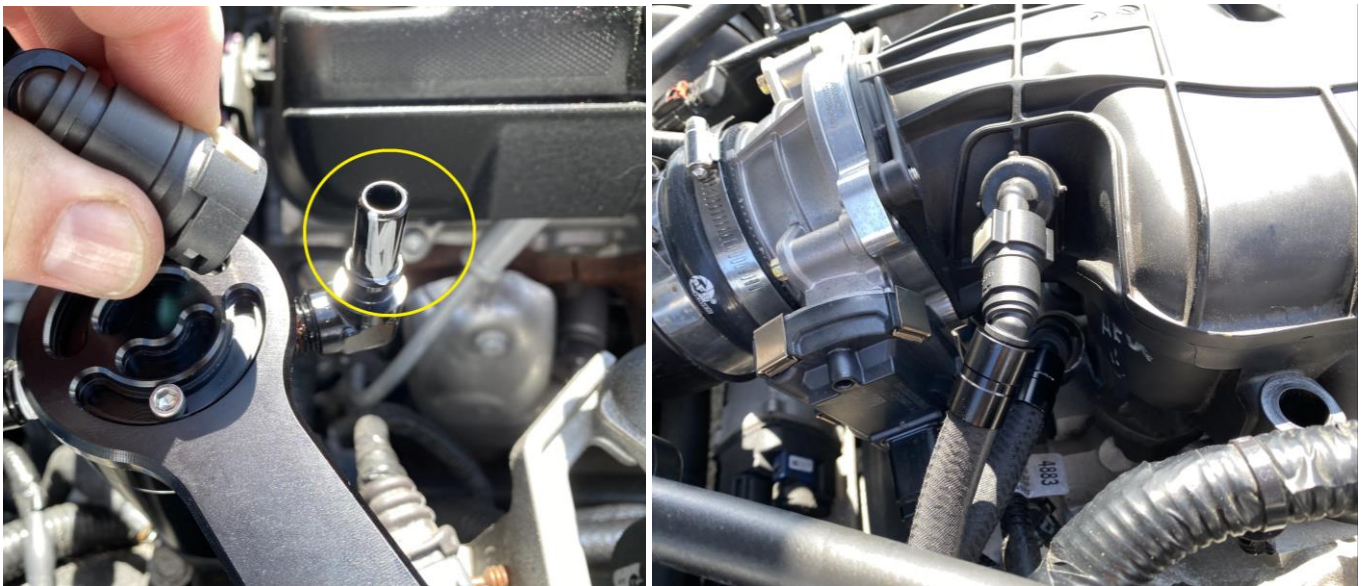
5028-96 / 96-1 14-19 C7 Corvette



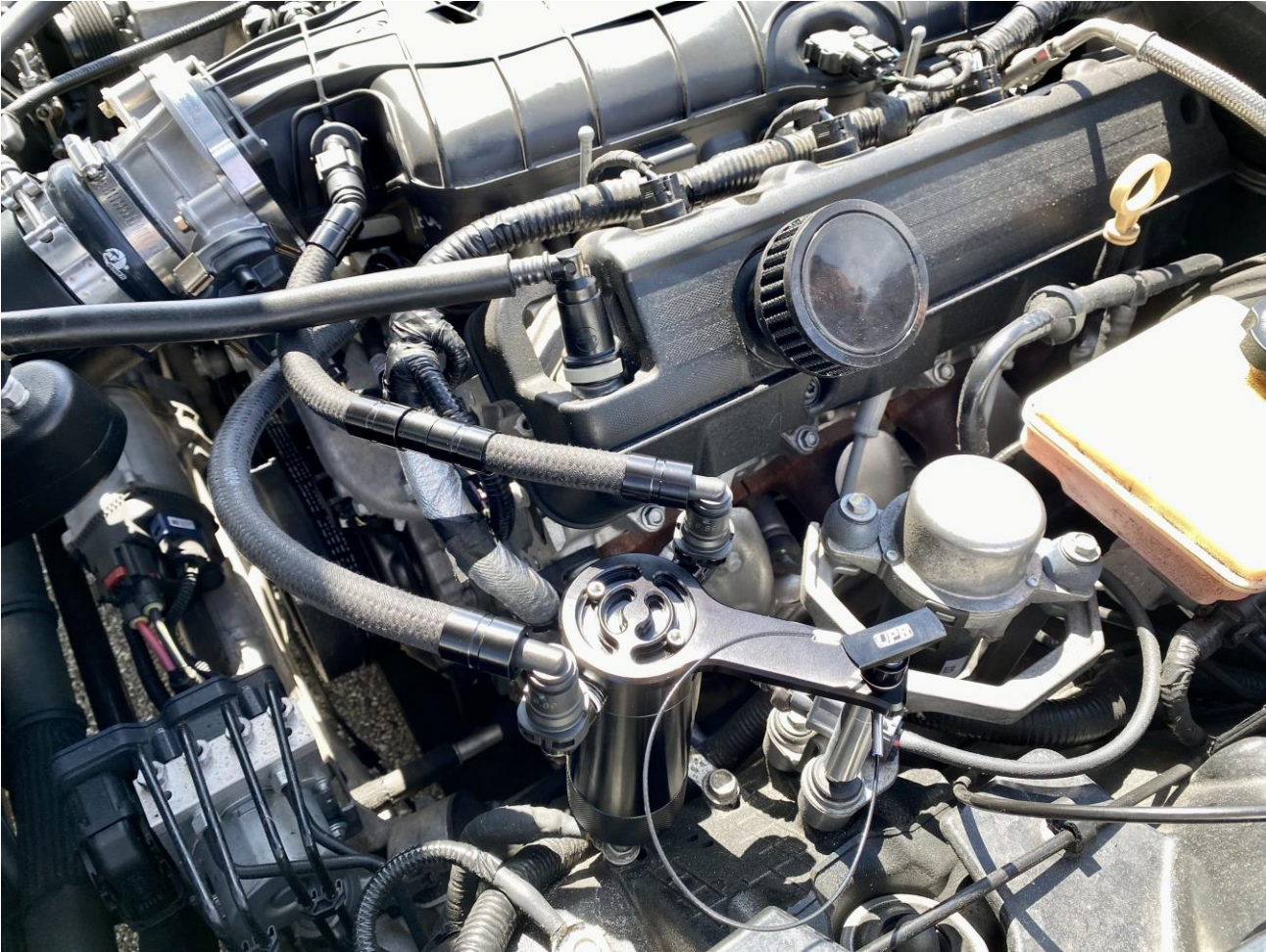
1. Locate the forward vacuum pump bolt, and use a 10mm socket to remove it. Install the Provided stud in it's place. Leave  $\frac{3}{4}$  of an inch of the stud above the nut. Tighten the lower nut to secure the stud. Screw the round mount onto the stud, then tighten by using the upper nut.



2. Lift the engine cover and locate the Factory PCV hose. It will connect from the intake manifold vacuum fitting, just behind the throttle body on the driver side of the engine to the PCV fitting in the lifter valley plate. Press the buttons on the fittings to remove the hose.



3. The outlet fitting on the catch can will have a silver mark on the end. This will connect to the intake manifold. The hose connecting to the manifold will have a check valve in it. Be sure the arrow on the check valve faces away from the catch can, towards the engine. Connect the other side of the catch can to the fitting in the lifter valley. To release the UPR Plug N Play connectors, squeeze both grey buttons, never pry them out.



4. Tighten the quick release catch can knob, and double check your connections. To service the catch can, Press the grey buttons on the hose end fittings then slide the fittings off the catch can. Unscrew the quick release knob and remove the catch can. Unscrew the catch can cup from the catch can body. Always dispose of the liquid with your used drain oil. Wipe out the catch can, oil the o ring, and reassemble. All catch can components including the hoses can be cleaned with warm water and dish soap if needed.

Always check and drain the catch can more often in winter / freezing weather. If the water/oil mixture in the catch can is allowed to freeze it will cause damage to the catch can and internal components. Any damage due to freezing is NOT WARRANTY. You must dispose of the liquid collected in the catch can properly (with used waste oil) properly according to your local laws.
