

UPR Oil Catch Can Installation

19 – up GM CHEVROLET GMC TRUCK 5.3L and 6.2 SINGLE VALVE CATCH CAN PLUG N PLAY

1. Remove the battery hold down bolt. Install your UPR Catch Can bracket in this location.



2. Remove the PCV hose connecting the driver's side valve cover to the vacuum port on intake manifold. Press the grey buttons on the fittings to release them.



3. Install the 'Clean Side' hose from the side fitting on the catch canto the vacuum fitting on the intake manifold. (if you selected to add the Billet Pro Series check valve, the arrow on the check valve faces away from the catch can)





4. Install the "Dirty Side" PCV hose onto the top fitting of the catch can, and connect it to the driver side valve cover.

The UPR catch can is easily serviced by removing the quick release knob, releasing the quick release fittings by pressing the grey buttons (**never pry the buttons out**) and disconnecting the hoses. Unscrew the catch can cup and dispose of the contents with used waste oil and dispose waste oil according to your local laws. The catch can and components are easily washed with warm water and dish soap. If need be, the catch can and components can be removed and the vehicle can be returned to stock for dealer service.

Tips: Be sure to check your catch can in 1000 mile intervals until you do your first oil change so you know how much oil your PCV system is ingesting and how frequent to check the can. 2. In colder months you will need to check the catch can more frequent as it will collect moisture and need to be emptied. 3. Cleaning tips you will only use a good quality dish soap and nothing else to cut and oil or much that collects over time. As any other cleaner can damage the anodizing and discolor the can.

Always check and drain the catch can more often in winter / freezing weather. If the water/oil mixture in the catch can is allowed to freeze it will cause damage to the catch can and internal components. Any damage due to freezing is NOT WARRANTY.
