



UPR Off Road X-Pipe Instructions (86-95)

Note: It's recommended to spray the nuts on the factory H pipe with WD-40 or other type of penetrant to loosen the nuts as they tend to rust and depending on the age of the car can be difficult to break loose.

- 1. Jack the front and rear of the car up and support with jack stands under the frame.
- 2. Un-screw the O2 sensors from the front and rear of the factory H pipe.
- 3. Disconnect the air tube coming from the emissions pump and cap off with a ¾" rubber end cap and clamp or you can delete your smog pump with our 3005 Smog Pump Eliminator Kit.
- 4. Remove the four nuts holding the cat back to the H pipe.
- 5. Remove the four nuts holding the front of the H pipe to the stock manifolds. A swivel socket and long extensions are recommended to reach the nuts.
- 6. Slide the H pipe backwards to slide it off of the hanger attached to the transmission mount.
- 7. Line up the large portion of the X pipe with the passenger side studs on the exhaust manifold and hand tighten the two factory nuts.
- 8. Line up the short portion of the X pipe with the driver side studs on the exhaust manifold and the center section of the X pipe and hand tighten the two factory nuts and use two of the supplied 3/8 bolts/nuts and washers to attach it to the center section.
- 9. Using a floor jack raise the center of the X pipe up close to the body of the car.
- 10. Using the remaining hardware enclosed bolt the factory cat back up to the X-pipe.
- 11. Tighten the front factory nuts on the X-pipe, then the two nuts/bolts holding the short arm of the X pipe to the main body.
- 12. Now tighten the rear nuts/bolts and remove the jack.
- 13. Re-install the O2 sensors on the car.
- 14. Tie strap any wires that are close to the exhaust away.
- 15. Lower the car back to the ground.
